North Devon Council protocol on recording/filming at Council meetings

The Council is committed to openness and transparency in its decision-making. Recording is permitted at Council meetings that are open to the public. Members of the public that attend meetings must be aware that these meetings are open to the public and so therefore both individuals and the Council itself have the right to record the meeting. The Council understands that some members of the public attending its meetings may not wish to be-filmed. The Chair of the meeting will make sure any request not to be filmed is respected.

The rules that the Council will apply are:

- 1. The recording must be overt (clearly visible to anyone at the meeting) and must not disrupt proceedings. The Council will put signs up at any meeting where we know recording is taking place.
- 2. The Chair of the meeting has absolute discretion to stop or suspend recording if, in their opinion, continuing to do so would prejudice proceedings at the meeting or if the person recording is in breach of these rules.
- 3. We will ask for recording to stop if the meeting goes into 'part B' where the public is excluded for confidentiality reasons. In such a case, the person recording should leave the room ensuring all recording equipment is switched off.
- 4. Any member of the public has the right not to be filmed. We ensure that agendas for, and signage at, Council meetings make it clear that recording can take place anyone not wishing to be filmed must advise the Chair at the earliest opportunity to allow them to be directed to an area in the room where they will not be caught on camera. Subject to paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 above, audio recordings shall be permitted at all times during public meetings.
- 5. The recording should not be edited in a way that could lead to misinterpretation or misrepresentation of the proceedings or in a way that ridicules or shows a lack of respect for those in the recording. The Council would expect any recording in breach of these rules to be removed from public view.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. Each year the Off Street Parking Order is reviewed to ensure compliance and correctness for use.
- 1.2. Each year the conditions and charges have been considered by the Strategy & Resources Committee to maintain compliance and suitability.

2. RECOMMENDATIONS

Strategy & Resources Committee agree to carry out a consultation as requested by parishes and include amendments for North Devon Council Car Parks as set out below; this will be effective from 1st April 2025.

2.1. To give delegated power to the Head of Place Property and Regeneration in consultation with the Leader, Senior Solicitor and Monitoring Officer to make the Order following the consultation subject to there being no material objections or amendments necessary

2.2. Braunton Parish Council

Braunton Parish Council have not requested any amendments.

2.3 Combe Martin Parish Council

Combe Martin Parish Council have not requested any amendments.

2.4 Instow Parish Council

Strategy & Resources Committee to accept changes to charges and regulations for Instow Marine car park and include the amendments into the Off Street Parking as described below and shown in Appendix A

2.5 Lynton & Lynmouth Town Council

Strategy & Resources Committee to accept changes to charges and regulations for Bottom Meadow, Cross Street, Esplanade, Lower Lyndale, Upper Lyndale, Upper Valley of Rocks, Valley of Rocks and Watersmeet car parks and include the amendments into the Off Street Parking as described below and shown in Appendix A



2.6 South Molton Town Council

3. REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS

To update the Off Street Parking Order to reflect the current needs of Parish, Town and District Councils following the annual review and to propose changes to the level of car park charges applied.

4. REPORT

The report is divided between Parish requests and amendments to the current order for correctness, North Devon Council requests that the amendments are adopted and accepted to the current order for correctness.

The Definitions have been reviewed and amended.

The Scale of Charges has been reviewed and amended – both the previous and amended versions have been provided for comparison.

North Devon Council Amendments

Request is made to Strategy & Resources Committee to accept and adopt within the North Devon (Off Street Parking Places) Order the amendments to the regulations for Off Street parking places within the management and control of North Devon Council, as follows:

Barnstaple

- **1.** To accept and adopt the changes to the terminology, definitions and scale of charges as shown in Appendix B.
- **2.** To accept and adopt the creation of a Seven Brethren Long Stay annual permit to incentivise use of the new car park.
- **3.** To accept and adopt the removal of the 'Van' tariff, to be renamed 'Oversized' defined as a vehicle that cannot be parked wholly within a standard parking bay and added to the Lorry/Coach tariff. Specification included on Appendix A (Part 2, main body of text).



- **4.** To accept and adopt the addition of the requirement for all vehicles being legal and roadworthy, specifically valid motor insurance, vehicle tax and MOT to Part 2 Use of Land and Parking place. This will assist with the enforcement and support the partnership with DVLA.
- **5.** To accept and adopt the increase in price for a Bickington Residents permits bringing it in line with other resident permits.
- **6.** To accept and adopt the removal of the Rolle Quay Reserved permits due to lack of public interest.
- **7.** The increase in price for 4 & 7 day season and Rover permits in line with the increase of tariffs.

- 5.1. The charges were last reviewed in March 2023, over the last two years the impact from inflation has increased annual running costs on the Council budget.
- 5.2. The changes and review of car park charges for Barnstaple, Ilfracombe,, Lynton & Lynmouth and South Molton will increase revenue by an estimated £357,000 which would be factored into the 2025/26 revenue budget..
- 5.3. The proposed changes will also bring car parks across all town and parishes in line with each other to ensure consistency and fairness across North Devon.

The Seven Brethren Long Stay car park will remain on the Barnstaple Long Stay permit in consideration of existing users as well as the creation of a permit specifically for the Seven Brethren Long Stay car park itself. The removal of the Rolle Quay reserved bays will increase the availability for Pay & Display car park users.

The NORTH DEVON DISTRICT COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 32, Section 35 and Section 35(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the County Council of Devon in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order may be cited as the North Devon (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2024 and shall come into operation at midnight on 31st March 2025

PART 2: USE OF LAND AND PARKING PLACE

2.1 Each area of land specified by name in the Schedule may be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order as a Parking Place for such classes of Vehicles in such positions on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that area in the Schedule.

- 2.2 Where in the Schedule a Parking Place is described as available for Vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position, the driver of a Vehicle shall not permit it to remain in that Parking Place unless it is of the class and in the position so specified.
- 2.3 The permitted classes of Vehicles must park wholly within a Parking Bay set aside for that class of Vehicle.
- 2.4 Where, within a Parking Place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a Parking Bay is available only for a Disabled Badge Holder, such indication being either by words or symbols, the driver of a Vehicle shall not park it nor permit it to remain in that Parking Bay unless the driver or passenger is a Disabled Badge Holder.
- 2.5 Where, within a Parking Place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that the Parking Place, Parking Bay or Bays is/are a Reserved Bay or Parking Place available for virtual permit holders only, or is not available for use by members of the general public, such indication being either by words or symbols, the driver of a vehicle shall not park it or permit it to remain in that Parking Bay or Parking Place unless it is a vehicle authorised by the Council to park in that Parking Place or Parking Bay.
- 2.6 The driver of a vehicle of any class driving, reversing or manoeuvring a vehicle in any Parking Place shall not exceed a speed limit of 5 (FIVE) miles per hour.
- 2.7 The Articles of this Order shall apply to each and every Parking Place for all periods of every day inclusive of bank holidays, irrespective of whether there is a charge in force at any time for parking in the Parking Place.
- 2.8 The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to remain in a Parking Place for longer than the maximum period permitted for parking specified in the Schedule in relation to that Parking Place.

- 2.9 Where a Parking Place named in the Schedule has a restriction prohibiting a return to that Parking Place within a specified time period, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle to return to that Parking Place within that time period.
- 2.10 All vehicles using a parking place or area are required to be roadworthy and legal; specifically valid motor insurance, tax and MOT. Failure to comply may result in the vehicle being removed from the parking place or area.

PART 3: THE USE OF BARNSTAPLE BUS STATION

- 3.1 Barnstaple Bus Station ("the Bus Station") shall be in part used as a station for public service vehicles and in part as a Parking Place for certain classes of Vehicles subject to the following provisions of this Order:
 - (a) No vehicle other than a Public Service Vehicle shall be permitted to use the red land;
 - (b) All Public Service Vehicles setting down or picking up passengers within the red land shall do so only at one of the Designated Stands and in accordance with any agreement or arrangement entered into with the Council;
 - (c) The driver of any Public Service Vehicle shall not permit it to remain within the red land for longer than 30 minutes, unless authorised in writing by the Council;
 - (d) The driver of a Public Service Vehicle shall, on using the red land, pay the appropriate charge in accordance with the Scale of Charges specified within the Schedule, or such other charge as may be agreed in writing with the Council;
 - (e) The Charge referred to in (d) above shall be payable by Arrangement as agreed in writing with the Council;
 - (f) The blue land shall only be used by customers or clients of the "Go North Devon" scheme and shall not be used by any vehicle apart from a motor car or a disabled badge holder;

- (g) Upon parking the vehicle within the blue land, the driver of the same will immediately obtain a parking permit from the "Go North Devon" offices and display the same within the windscreen of the vehicle;
- (h) Where within the Bus Station there is any sign or surface marking indicating that the Bus Station, or any designated stand or space is not available for use by any particular vehicle or vehicles/ class of vehicle(s), has been closed, the driver of any vehicle shall not park it nor permit it to remain in the Bus Station or designated stand unless authorised to do so by the Council;
- The provisions of this Order shall apply to the Bus Station for all periods of every day, irrespective of bank holidays or weekends;
- (j) The driver of a vehicle using the Bus Station shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the Bus Station and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle or to depart from the Bus Station;
- (k) The driver of any vehicle shall not Park nor be permitted to Park a vehicle so unreasonably as to obstruct and/or prevent access to any other part of the Bus Station or any designated stand or space or so as to become a nuisance to any other user of the Bus Station;
- (I) Any vehicle in contravention of the provisions of this Order or any vehicle which is causing an obstruction or nuisance to other users of the Bus Station may be removed from the Bus Station by any authorised officer of the Council or on behalf of the Council by any authorised servant or agent in manner hereinafter appearing:
 - (i) the vehicle may be removed by towing or driving the vehicle or some other method as the Council, its officers or servant may deem appropriate and necessary to enable the position of the vehicle to be altered or the vehicle to be removed;
 - (ii) any person moving, removing or arranging the removal of a vehicle by virtue of this section of the Order shall make arrangements as he considers reasonably necessary for the safety of the vehicle in the place to which it is removed;

- (iii) in exercising its powers under this provision of the Order, the Council may recover the costs of removal and storage of the vehicle from the driver of the vehicle.
- (m) Notwithstanding the powers contained within the previous provision hereof, in the case of a vehicle in respect of which a breach of any provision of this Order may have occurred, an officer of the Council or any agents or servants of the Council may attach to the vehicle or public service vehicle, a PCN which shall include the following particulars:
 - (i) the name of the enforcement authority;
 - (ii) the date on which the notice is served;
 - (iii) the registration mark of the vehicle involved in the alleged contravention;
 - (iv) the date and time at which the alleged contravention occurred;
 - (v) the grounds on which the civil enforcement officer serving the notice believed that a penalty charge is payable;
 - (vi) the amount of the penalty charge;
 - (vii) the information that the penalty charge must be paid not later than the last day of the period of 28 days beginning with the date on which the penalty charge notice was served;
 - (viii) the information that, if the penalty charge is paid not later than the last day of the period of 14 days beginning with the date on which the notice is served, the penalty charge will be reduced by the amount of any applicable discount;
 - (ix) The information that if the penalty charge is not paid before the end of the period of 28 days a notice to owner may be served by the enforcement authority on the owner of the vehicle;
 - (x) The manner in which the penalty charge must be paid.
- (n) When a PCN has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with any of the foregoing provisions of this Order no person other than a person authorised by the Council on their behalf or the driver or a person

authorised by the driver on their behalf shall remove the same from the vehicle;

- (o) Where in the Bus Station, signs are erected or surface markings laid for the purpose of indicating the entrance to or exit from the Bus Station or indicating that a vehicle using a parking place should proceed in a specified direction within the Bus Station, no persons shall drive or permit to be driven any public service vehicle so that it enters or leaves the Bus Station otherwise than by an entrance or exit so indicated or in a direction other than such specified;
- (p) The Council may at its discretion suspend the operation of this Order in relation to the whole or any part of the Bus Station at any time and for whatever purpose it deems fit;
- (q) No person shall cause a nuisance or annoyance to other users of the Bus Station or to any Council employee nor interfere in any way with nor obstruct or cause to obstruct any part of the Bus Station nor any parking bay/area, designated stands, signs, meters or notices within the Bus Station;
- (r) For the purpose of the instigation of proceedings in respect of any breach of this Order the person responsible shall be deemed to be the registered keeper/ hirer of the vehicle;
- (s) Where a PCN has been issued and payment of the Penalty Charge has not been made within the time stated thereon, the Council may instigate proceedings in the Civil Court for the recovery of the penalty charge and any reasonable costs incurred by the Council in taking such proceedings.

PART 4: CHARGES

4.1 The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall pay the appropriate charge in accordance with the Scale of Charges specified in Schedule One provided that no charge shall be payable by the driver of a vehicle left in that parking place if either the vehicle displays a valid virtual permit issued in respect of that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph (3) of

this Article or, if that vehicle is parked in a parking place and remains within the parking place only during those days or hours of the day when no charge is payable as provided in Schedule One.

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- 4.2 The charge referred to in paragraph 4.1 shall be payable by one of the following methods:
 - (a) Pay and Display; or
 - (b) Payment via mobile phone; or
 - (c) some other arrangement as may be agreed in writing with the Council.
- 4.3 The owner of a vehicle may, on application to the Council, purchase a virtual permit in respect of a vehicle for a charge ascertained by reference to the Schedule and that virtual permit shall be valid in such parking places/ areas as are specified thereon during the period for which it is issued. The use of the said virtual permit shall be subject to the terms of this Order and to any additional terms or conditions specified by the council.
- 4.4 (a) Any Pay & Display ticket issued upon the payment of the charge in accordance with paragraph 4.2(a) ascertained by reference to Schedule One shall be maintained and continuously and conspicuously displayed inside the windscreen or on the dashboard of that vehicle throughout the entire parking period of the vehicle in respect of which it was issued or purchased;
 - (b) Said Pay & Display ticket must remain both visible and legible throughout that period to any person examining the vehicle from its exterior;
 - (c) Any virtual Parking Session issued in accordance with paragraph 4.3 must refer to that parking place/area in which it is parked at the time of observation;
 - (d) The Parking Session must be valid for the entire period for which the vehicle remains in that parking place/area and should relate to the vehicle registration parked during that period.
- 4.5 A vehicle shall not remain in a Parking Place if it displays any Pay & Display ticket or virtual Parking Session referred to in paragraph 4.4 hereof which has



expired or is invalidated either in the circumstances described in 4.6 below or if the Parking Session obtained via RingGo has expired or for any other reason.

- 4.6 Tickets referred to in 4.4 above shall not be transferred between vehicles, and for the avoidance of doubt, shall become invalid upon such a transfer taking place. Tickets purchased by RingGo are only valid if they refer to the correct registration number and Parking Place.
- 4.7 The charges payable in accordance with the Scale of Charges specified within Schedule One shall be payable in respect of all vehicles, including a Disabled Badge Holder.

PART 5: OTHER PROVISIONS

- 5.1 The driver of a Motor Vehicle shall comply with the terms of this Order and any ancillary matters specified within Schedule Six.
- 5.2 The driver of a Motor Vehicle using a Parking Place, shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the Parking Place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle or to depart from the Parking Place.
- 5.3 No person shall use any part of a Parking Place, or any vehicle left in a Parking Place, for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than carrying out such repairs as are reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the Parking Place.
- 5.4. The driver of a vehicle using a Parking Place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument or cause to be made any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the Parking Place or occupiers of premises or any other person in and around the neighbourhood.

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- 5.5 (a) If a vehicle is left in a Parking Place in a position other than in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 4, a person authorised by the Council may alter, or cause to be altered, the position of the vehicle so that its position is in accordance with said provisions;
 - (b) For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency, a person authorised by the Council, or a Police Officer in uniform, may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a Parking Place or remove or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a Parking Place.
 - (c) Any person altering or causing the alteration of the position of a vehicle by virtue of paragraph 5.1, removing or causing the removal of a vehicle by virtue of paragraph 5.2 may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think reasonably necessary to enable the position of the vehicle to be altered or the vehicle to be removed.
 - (d) Any person moving, removing or arranging the removal of a vehicle by virtue of paragraphs 5.2 or 5.3 of this Article shall make such arrangements as he considers to be reasonably necessary for the safety of the vehicle in the place to which it is removed.
 - (e) In exercising any of its powers hereunder, the Council may recover from the driver of the vehicle any reasonable costs and expenses which are incurred by the Council or its authorised agents.
- 5.6 In a Parking Place, no person shall:
 - (a) erect, cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the written consent of the Council;
 - (b) light, cause or permit to be lit any fire.
- 5.7 No person shall use a Parking Place or any Parking Bay when the Council have closed that Parking Place or Parking Bay.



The driver of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to be parked in a Parking Place, Parking Bay or area which it is stated, either within this Order, its Schedules, on signs, on the ground or otherwise to be available for reserved

parking only or where "No Parking" signs are erected or marked out on the ground or in an area marked with cross-hatch markings on the ground or in a Parking Place, Parking Bay or area which has been closed by the Council by any other method.

5.8

- 5.9 The driver of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to be parked so unreasonably as to obstruct and/or as to prevent access to any other Parking Place, Parking Bay or any premises adjoining the Parking Place or so as to become a nuisance to any other user of the Parking Place. Vehicles are not permitted to park beyond the Parking Bay markings.
- 5.10 (a) No person shall abandon a vehicle within a Parking Place or area.
 - (b) For the purposes of paragraph 5.1, a person who leaves a vehicle within a Parking Place in such circumstances or for such a period that he may reasonably be assumed to have abandoned it, shall be deemed to have abandoned it there unless a contrary intention is shown.
 - (c) If any boat or other article is left in a Parking Place without the consent of the Council, the Council may cause a Notice to be attached to, or placed near to, the boat or other article requiring the removal of the boat or other article within 7 days of the date of the Notice.
 - (d) If any boat or other article shall remain after the expiry of the said Notice the Council may remove or cause to be removed the same and shall recover any costs incurred in so doing from the owner thereof.
- 5.11 (a) Where an authorised officer has reasonable grounds to believe that a vehicle has contravened any of the conditions within this Order, they may attach a notice to the vehicle requesting that the vehicle be removed from

the Parking Place within not less than 24 hours of the time that the notice is affixed and that it should not return thereto.

- (b) Any vehicle remaining within the Parking Place after the expiry of the notice period, can be removed by any authorised Officer of the Council or on behalf of the Council by any authorised servant or agent in the manner set out in 5.11 above.
- (c) If a vehicle cannot be removed or it is deemed inappropriate for the Council to remove the vehicle, then an authorised Officer may serve a further notice by leaving it attached to the vehicle advising that all rights of occupation of the Parking Place are formally withdrawn and that unless the vehicle is removed within 24 hours of the date of service then action will be taken forthwith without further notice in the appropriate Court to have the vehicle and any occupiers removed.

PART 6: PENALTY CHARGE

- 6.1 In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a breach of this Order may have occurred, it shall be the duty of a Civil Enforcement Officer to provide notification of a Penalty Charge by notice affixed to the vehicle in a conspicuous position, or by notice given to the person appearing to be in charge of the vehicle or in such other manner as specified by Traffic Management Act 2004. The Penalty Charge Notice ("a PCN") shall include the following particulars:
 - (a) The name of the enforcement authority;
 - (b) The date on which the notice is served;
 - (c) The registration mark of vehicle involved in the alleged contravention;

- (d) The date and time at which the alleged contravention occurred;
- (e) The grounds on which the Civil Enforcement Officer serving the notice believed that a penalty charge is payable;
- (f) The amount of the penalty charge;
- (g) The information that the penalty charge must be paid not later than the last day of the period of 28 days beginning with the date on which the penalty charge notice was served;
- (h) The information that, if the penalty charge is paid not later than the last day of the period of 14 days beginning with the date on which the notice is served, the penalty charge will be reduced by the amount of any applicable discount;
- (i) The information that if the penalty charge is not paid before the end of the period of 28 days a notice to owner may be served by the enforcement authority on the owner of the vehicle; and
- (j) The manner in which the penalty charge must be paid.
- 6.2 When a PCN has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with any of the foregoing provisions of this Order, no person other than a person authorised by the Council in that behalf or the driver or a person authorised by the driver in that behalf shall remove the same from the vehicle.

PART 7: GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 7. Where in a Parking Place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:
 - (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the Parking Place,

(b) indicating that a vehicle using a Parking Place shall proceed in a specified direction within the Parking Place,

no person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle:

- (i) so that it enters the Parking Place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the Parking Place otherwise than by an exit so indicated; or
- (ii) in a direction other than so specified.
- 7.1 No person shall, except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council on their behalf, drive or permit to be driven any vehicle in a Parking Place for any purpose other than the purpose of parking that vehicle in the Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of this Order.
- 7.2 No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a Parking Place in connection with the sale of an article to persons in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering to hire of his skill or services except with the prior written consent of the Council.
- 7.3 No person shall use any part of a Parking Place as an "Operating Centre", within the meaning of the Transport Act 1968, unless the prior written consent of the Council in the form of a licence has been granted.
- 7.4 No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited, any advertising handbills, leaflets or circulars on any vehicle in a Parking Place. Without prejudice to the generality of this article, a person shall be deemed to be causing an advert, handbill, leaflet or circular to be deposited if his goods, trade, business or other concerns are being given publicity by the advert, handbill, leaflet or circular unless he can prove that it was deposited without his consent.
- 7.5 The Council may, at its discretion, suspend the operation of this Order in relation to the whole or any part of any Parking Place at any time and for

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whatever purpose it deems fit. This is without prejudice to the Council's right to close the Parking Place or one or more Parking Bays within the Parking Place.

- 7.6 No person shall cause a nuisance or annoyance to other users of a Parking Place or to any Council employee nor interfere in any way with, nor obstruct or cause to obstruct, any Parking Place or any Parking Bay, sign, meter or notice within any Parking Place.
- 7.7 Where a PCN has been issued and payment of the Penalty Charge has not been made within the time stated thereon, the Council may instigate proceedings in the Civil Court for the recovery of the penalty charge and any reasonable costs incurred by the Council in taking such proceedings.
- 7.8 For the purpose of the instigation of proceedings in respect of any breach of this Order or non-payment of a penalty charge, the person responsible shall be deemed to be the Registered Keeper or hirer of the vehicle.
- 7.9 (a) No vehicle boat or other article or thing shall be left or parked on a parking place in such a position as may cause a nuisance or danger to the safety of users of the parking place.
 - (b) Any vehicle boat or other article or thing which has been left in a Parking Place in breach of sub-clause (a) hereof may be removed from the Parking Place by any person who has been duly authorised by the Council.
 - (c) The Council may make such arrangements as it considers reasonable for the safe custody of the vehicle, boat or other article or thing.
 - (d) The Council will, upon being furnished with evidence of ownership, return the vehicle boat or other article or thing to the person who appears to the Council to be the owner of the same, SUBJECT TO payment of the reasonable costs of the Council incurred in removing and/or storing the same.

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(e) Any boat vehicle or other article so removed will be deemed to have been abandoned unless claimed within 3 months of removal.
