- (2) Any decision involving capital expenditure in excess of £100k not included in the approved capital programme
- (3) Any decision to spend from the Executive Contingency Reserve (Policy Initiatives/Financial Planning) in excess of £50k.

or

(4) to be significant in terms of its effects on communities living or working in an area comprising two or more wards or electoral divisions in the area of the Local Authority.
