park should be kept as is; looking after what is already built should be more of a priority than new housing developments

pollution from construction traffic and new properties; the park is the only 'green area' we have; proposed new green space will be too far away from the children and elderly residents to access; wildlife and birds will be displaced; suggest a bat survey be undertaken; the park will no longer be safe; our area is well established and works well as it is; a new housing development should have its own facilities and access.

pollution from traffic; consider the Government's Clean Air Strategy 2019; road will devalue properties; will have an adverse effect on wildlife and bird habitats; park is the only green space we have; proposed new green area is on a hill and too far away to get to safely

Westacott Road already receives a lot of heavy traffic; no traffic calming measures in place to prevent accident; road to new development should be via a roundabout at Landkey junction; bus lane through Castle Park Road; reduction in green space

air pollution increased; environmental impact; disturbance to wildlife and community space

Proposed new park location is not acceptable to the elderly; children would be further from the security of their own homes; pollution from increased traffic - consider Government's Air Pollution commitment; creation of a traffic rat run; suggestion alternative access routes suggest alternative route

increase traffic on the road to the play area, making it unsafe for children; already little in the way of green public space

taking away the safe place for children to play, it is a vital space for residents physical and mental wellbeing; loss of wildlife habitat additional traffic detrimental to those that live nearby, adding noise, pollution and potential added danger

removal of the play equipment would be disgusting to the memory of the late Councillor Dave Butt; increase in air pollution; suggest using another option for an access road; would create a rat run with increased volumes of traffic

air quality - refer to the Council's Air Quality Improvement document; already have written assurance to the community that no part of Westacott Park would be sold; Highways Authority have recorded that there is no need to sell any part of the park, suggest an alternative access.

moving the park facility is not acceptable as elderly residents may not be able to travel the xtra distance; park is our only green space; take note of Air Pollution reduction commitments; suggest alternative access route
