Ref: Premises Licensing Application at Freshwell Camping EX33 INP

Dear Sir,

We are the closest resident to this site and object to this application on the following grounds:

1 This camping ground is in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) and adjacent to a Coastline of Special Scientific Interest or "Heritage Coast". The additional litter produced from bottles and cans will detract from the beauty and serenity of the area. Litter is already a problem in this area as visitors drop (half empty) coffee containers, bottles and cans on the coastal footpath as well as in the gardens, driveways and wheelie bins of local residents - this license would make the problem worse.

2 Croyde Village was, in the past, designated an "Alcohol Free Zone" to stop visitors from walking around with open alcohol containers and misbehaving - the more easily alcohol can be purchased in Freshwell campsite the more likely it is that some people will walk around while drinking it on the coastal footpath, AONB etc and become a nuisance.

3 If this license application is allowed then the other camping grounds will also want the additional income and the whole area will suffer.

4 In recent years there has been an increase in instances of alcohol fuelled parties being held on the beach with bonfires, loud music and raucous behaviour - they go on until the early hours of the morning - this licence could only add to the problem.
