I have recently been informed of the above and as a resident of this village I am very concerned for the following reasons, if this application is successful.

Concerns :-

Parking in this area was granted originally for use for local vendors to park their vehicles.

There are already 3 food trucks trading; playing loud music to which Police & Environmental Health have been called out to.

The site is very close to residential property where a family live with their children.

It is close to the Public footpath which leads to the beach so "Litter" is likely to be an issue.

The Siding of the Horse box is close to Village Hall and Green, the latter being recently refurbished; Play area for children with a skateboard park.

The Council must be aware of the numerous establishments which already have licences to sell alcohol and these businesses have very strict guidelines to follow regarding sales and playing of music and they all have safe areas for their customers.

There are residents living in the Village centre who will have to endure 7 days a week of daytime music should this application be successful.

Why would there be any need for yet another outlet for alcohol sales when

There is plenty of choice already available in the centre of the village.

I believe that encouraging Off-sales of Alcohol, with little policing, will lead to incidences of public nuisance and disorder, which in turn will affect the safety of the Public, both young and old and it for these reasons that I object to the application being granted.
