license meeting outcome for sandleigh tearooms

Good morning all

As promised please see below the compromises and agreements made at our meeting last Monday.

We have agreed

- Amend the current application
- the amendments will set out a time of 11am-5pm for licensed activities but our opening hours are from 10am until 6pm.
- we will remove the off sales from the new application and only sell to ON.
- we will apply for TENS notices for the planned BBQ nights on a Friday during peak period (June – September) up to a maximum of 6 TENS during this period
- we have agreed the BBQ nights will finish at 8pm with a view to all customers having left the grounds by 9pm
- we will involve CARA, the parish council and Brian Whitty in the consultation process at each step
- we agree to non-amplified music only
- we will take the steps shown below to ensure we are complying with the 4 licensing objectives

Licensing objective control measures

- we will ensure all children are accompanied by an adult (no under 18 to be allowed without adult supervision)
- we will operate a think/challenge 25 policy
- we will operate a refusals log
- we will decant alcoholic drinks in toughened glasses
- we will regularly clean, clear and monitor tables.
- We will operate at a maximum capacity of 80 during TENS events
- We will ensure staff are comprehensively trained
- We will provide empty and monitor recycling facilities and waste facilities
