To update the Off Street Parking Order to reflect the current needs of Parish, Town and District Councils following the annual review.

In ensuring the draft Order is correct and reflects the needs for which it is intended, there are a number of amendments that have been made since it was last before Strategy and Resources Committee. North Devon Council requests that the amendments are adopted and accepted to the current Order for completeness.

Proposed Amendments

4.1 Barnstaple

 a) Lower Pilton - the addition of D4 (Monday to Saturday (including Bank Holidays)



4.2 **Braunton**

- a) Caen Street Car Park the removal of D3 (Monday to Saturday inclusive)
- b) Chaloners Road Car Park the removal of D3 (Monday to Saturday inclusive)

4.3 **Combe Martin**

- a) Kiln Car Park the addition of P1 (Virtual and paper tickets are only valid for the period of purchase. Paper tickets must be clearly displayed in the vehicle at all times)
- b) The Parade Car Park the addition of P1 (Virtual and paper tickets are only valid for the period of purchase. Paper tickets must be clearly displayed in the vehicle at all times)

4.4 Ilfracombe

- a) Hele the addition of D4 (Monday to Saturday (including Bank Holidays)
- b) Ropery Road Car Park the addition of H3 (8:00am to 8:00pm from 15 March to 31 October)

4.5 Instow

- a) Instow Marine Car Park the removal of H2 (8.00am to 6.00pm)
- b) Instow Marine Car Park the addition of H22 (8.00am to 10.00pm)
- c) Instow Marine Car Park the increase of permits to £175.00

4.6 **Lynton and Lynmouth**

- a) Manor Foreshore the addition of P1 (Virtual and paper tickets are only valid for the period of purchase. Paper tickets must be clearly displayed in the vehicle at all times)
- b) Manor Gardens Roadway the removal of all codes except H21 (parking prohibited at any time)

4.7 **South Molton**

- a) Sheep Pen Car Park the addition of D4 (Monday to Saturday (including Bank Holidays)
- b) South Molton Central the addition of D4 (Monday to Saturday (including Bank Holidays)

4.8 Charges

a) the removal of C58 in its entirety (£120 per annum for Adelaide Terrace Resident's Association Only)



b) the addition of C62 (3hrs: £3.90, 4hrs: £5.20, 5hrs: £6.50, 6hrs: £7.80, 7hrs: £9.10, All Day: £10.00)
